Gentlemen.

In accordance with our appointment, we have audited the books and accounts of your Municipality for the year ended December 31, 1965. Our examination included a general review of the accounting procedures and such to a securiting records and other supporting evidence as we considered necessary in the circumstances.

#### REMARKS AND EXPLANATIONS:

#### Ballance Sheet - Current Fund

Cash on Hand:

Wo harm counted the eash on hand as at December 31, 1965.

#### Cash in Bank and Bank Loan

The balance in the bank accounts were confirmed by your depositional together with the balance of the bank loan. The outstanding cheques exceeded the cash in the bank accounts which would indicate an overdraft. Section 329(1) of the Municipal Act provides that bank borrowings must be by way of promissory note only. As at December 31, 1965 the bank loans exceeded 70, par cent of the uncollected balance of the revenues for the year, contrary to the provisions of Section 329(3) of the Municipal Act.

#### Taxes and Interest Receivable

The balance of taxes receivable amounted to \$103,964.39 as at December 31, 1965 as compared to \$109,651.99 as at December 31, 1964 and \$153,563.14 as at December 31, 1963. During the course of our audit, tax expears verification notices were sent to all raterayers who were in arrears at the cond of the year.

#### Advinces on Drainage Schemes \$28,284.37

This amount is made up of a number of drainage schemes and represents the balance due from the interested parties which will be paid a number of years.

#### Latters of Credit - Parks & Gardens Home Development Ltd

Letters of credit of \$271,350.39 have been posted to be applied to payments for municipal services as they become due.

#### Surrent Surplus

The balance of the surplus account as at December 31, 1965 stood at \$8,060.67 after having made adjustments affecting operations of prior years and credited the 1965 surplus of \$6,056.65. The reserve for working funds has been increased by \$9,184.61 and now stands at \$80,484.62.

#### GENERAL ILMARKS

We have verified in detail the collection of taxes and other revenue with the receipts and vouchers. All cheques drawn on the Township's bank accounts were also verified with the vouchers and approval of the minute book.

The postings to the general ledger have been verified with the books of original entry.

The minutes and by-laws have been examined and noted.

The municipality has a Surety Bond for the Clerk-Treasurer of \$5,000.00 with the Dominion of Canada General Insurance Co. expiring July 1, 1965. The clerical assistants are also bended for \$5,000.00

We have also examined all insurance policies covering the municipality.

#### AUDITORS: OPINION

Subject to the foregoing, we hereby report that in our opinion:

- (1) The financial transactions which have come under our notices have been within the powers of the Municipality.
- (2) The audit has been conducted in accordance with the instruction of the Department of Municipal Affairs.
- (3) The financial statements present fairly the financial position of the Municipality as at December 31, 1965 and the results of its operations for the year ended on that date.
