

	Dan is willing to make planters. He is trying to get free wood to make this happen.
	We are aware of the rat problems in Orleans. Some of the solutions are don't feed the birds and squirrels as their food will attract the rats. Don't have any water feeders around. This also attracts rats.
	Some poison was installed in the sewers but that didn't work well as the rats were being fed by bird and squirrel feeders. If you have wood piles, get rid of them if possible. If you suspect rats in your area, install 1 ¼ inch steel mesh. They are rodent proof.
